



## **AT&T DIGITAL LIFE Smoke Sensor Policy**

Many homes are required to have smoke detectors that are wired to the home's 120V power. AT&T Digital Life smoke sensors are battery powered and do not connect to or replace existing smoke detectors. AT&T Digital Life professionally monitors and is notified when its smoke sensors are triggered. **AT&T Digital Life is not notified if pre-existing or non-AT&T certified smoke detectors are triggered.**

In single family, detached homes, AT&T Digital Life smoke sensors are intended to be used in conjunction with the home's pre-existing wired smoke detectors. AT&T Digital Life smoke sensors are not currently available for use in any townhome or duplex that shares walls. For all housing units, pre-existing wired smoke detectors must remain in place and be fully operational. AT&T Digital Life smoke sensors should only be used in areas already covered by your pre-existing wired smoke detectors. AT&T Digital Life smoke sensors operate best when in room temperature environments - not extreme heat or cold areas like attics, garages or near stoves. AT&T Digital Life smoke sensors may be placed next to pre-existing wired smoke detectors and should not exceed the number of pre-existing wired smoke detectors. For example, if your home has five (5) pre-existing wired smoke detectors, you may have between one (1) and five (5) AT&T Digital Life smoke sensors installed, either professionally or installed yourself.
